## Joplin Public Library has recently replaced thirty six patron computers thanks to a Library Services and Technology Act grant from the Missouri State Library. The current machines were installed when the Library first opened over eight years ago, and nearing the end of support life for their operating systems. The Library had seen an increase in failures with the hardware and faced crashes and stalls in service. With a higher door count and computer session counts steadily

The new computers are Dell Pro 24 All-in-One 65W desktops with Intel® Core™ Ultra 7 265. They include Windows 11 Pro, integrated graphics, 16 GB DDR5, 256 GB SSD, Bluetooth and Wifi6. These machines required no alterations to the Library's environment to accommodate, and offered more quality ports than other devices. They allowed the Library to build a model that fit our specific needs without forcing unwanted features and higher costs. The bundle included a wireless keyboard and mouse which freed up two critical ports.
