- ★ Participate in a library program or activity
- ★ Step outside your comfort zone—read a type of book you don't normally read: nonfiction, graphic novel/manga, science fiction, fantasy, dystopian, humor, mystery, romance, horror, etc. (Don't forget to log this on your reading log)
- ★ Play a board game, cards, chess, tabletop RPG, or an outside game
- ★ Try one of our e-resources: Mango Languages, Libby, Hoopla, Kanopy, drivingTests.org, Learning express Library. Ask a librarian for a demo
- ★ Do something outside or explore nature
- ★ Tell someone about a book you really like
- ★ Stop by the Library's teen department and wave at the librarians
- ★ Explore a different country through a book, a map, Google maps, or a documentary/YouTube video
- ★ Create a bucket list for the summer, the next school year, or beyond
- ★ Cook a dish/meal with ingredients that are new to you
- ★ Say something kind to someone
- ★ Make some art with nature—get creative by using berries or flower petals as color, or whatever you can think of
- ★ Create a playlist for outdoor adventures like hiking: this can be music, podcasts, or audiobooks
- ★ Do something good for the environment through outdoor adventuring—recycle, pick up trash from your neighborhood or local park, or plant a flower
- ★ Read outside
- ★ Research insects or plants native to Missouri and then try to find some of them outdoors
- ★ Make bad art (paint with no goal, draw using only stick figures, or scribble)
- ★ Watch a movie with the sound muted and the subtitles on (or watch a subbed anime)
- ★ Go bird, animal, or insect watching
- ★ Read a book from a suggested reading list or make your own list

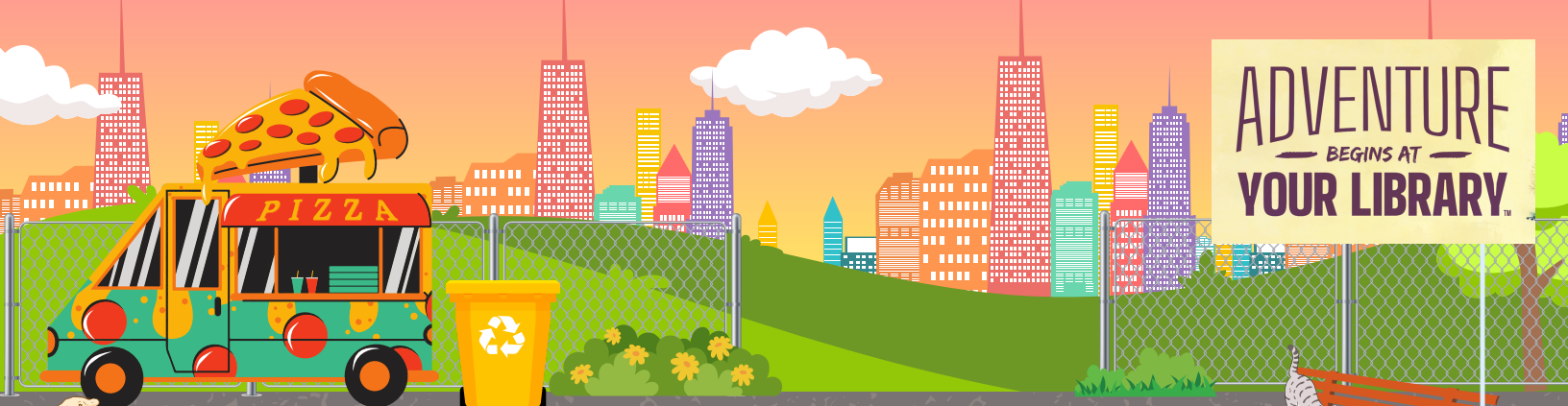
