- The free Summer Meals collaboration with Joplin Schools Nutritional Services Department has been well received, with an average of 30 meals being served per day.
- On July 6, the Library hosted a puzzle competition for adults. Small groups competed to see who could finish a 500 piece puzzle the fastest. Twenty-six individuals completed.
- On July 9, the Library hosted a Tiny Art Night event for teens and adults. Sixty-four individuals participated.
- On July 12, Max the Magician wowed 152 audience members with his "Magic Begins at Your Library" show.
- Only July 13, as part of the all ages Four State Museum of Natural History program, paleontologist Brad Shelby shared about his trip to Montana to dig for dinosaur bones. He also shared a display of fossils representing dinosaurs who would have once lived in the four-state area. Ninety-three individuals were in attendance.
