## Makerspace Policies

## General

- 1. Makers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult when starting a project in the Makerspace.
- 2. No food in the Makerspace.
- 3. Non-alcoholic drinks are permitted, so long as they are covered and kept on the counter.
- 4. Makers are expected to adhere to the Joplin Public Library's "Library Rules for Patrons".
- 5. Makers are expected to leave the Makerspace before closing.
- 6. Makers who are no-shows for appointments will lose their appointment privileges after the second no-show.

## Equipment Use

- 1. Makers are expected to use Makerspace equipment in accordance with the manufacturer's suggested safety precautions.
- 2. The laser cutter/engraver is available by appointment only, since staff assistance is required.
- 3. Makerspace equipment, excluding the laser cutter/engraver, is available for up to two hours on a first come, first serve basis, if no appointment has been made.
- 4. Supplies provided by the library must be used on the 3D printer and the button press and a small cost recovery fee will apply.
- 5. Makers are responsible for the completion of their own projects.
- 6. Makers may not download or install software on the Makerspace computers.
- 7. At its discretion, staff reserves the right to disallow the use of any tools, equipment or consumable material, or to halt, delete, or disallow the creation of items that could harm Makerspace equipment or that violate any library policy.
- 8. Makerspace equipment may not be used to create weapons.

Failure to adhere to these policies may result in the loss of Makerspace privileges.
